## SUMMARIES OF AMENDMENTS AND COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTES

### SENATE BILLS

**S 794. [ADJOURN RECONVENED SESSION](#).** Filed 1/4/12. House amendment makes the following changes to 1st edition. States that when the House and Senate adjourn the reconvened session of the 2011 General Assembly, they stand adjourned to reconvene as provided in Resolution 2011-12, *which is amended* as follows. Reconvenes the 2011 Regular Session on January 5, 2012, at 12:45 a.m. (was, on February 16, 2012, at noon), and only allows consideration of (1) bills returned by the Governor for the purpose of veto overrides, and (2) a joint resolution further adjourning to a date certain. Provides that when the House and Senate adjourn on January 5, 2012, they will reconvene on February 16, 2012, at noon.

### Legislation Enacted

**SL 2011-419 (H 796). [BREWERIES/COMM. COLL./SUPP. FUND. CLARIFIED](#).** AN ACT TO ALLOW ALL PERMITTEES THAT HAVE BEEN ISSUED A BREWERY PERMIT BY THE NORTH CAROLINA ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL COMMISSION TO SELL AT RETAIL MALT BEVERAGES THAT HAVE BEEN MANUFACTURED AT THE BREWERY OR AT ANOTHER LOCATION OUT OF STATE BY THE SAME PERMITTEE ONLY ON THE PREMISES OF THE BREWERY AFTER RECEIVING THE PROPER PERMITS, TO CLARIFY THAT CERTAIN HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS MAY BE PERMITTED TO TAKE NONCREDIT COURSES AT STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGES, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION TO ALLOT SMALL COUNTY SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING TO THE CHEROKEE COUNTY SCHOOLS.
