SL 2012-195 (S 655). [DENTISTRY MANAGEMENT ARRANGEMENTS](#). AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT DENTIST AGREEMENTS WITH MANAGEMENT COMPANIES CONFORM WITH THE DENTAL PRACTICE ACT AND TO ESTABLISH A TASK FORCE ON DENTAL MANAGEMENT ARRANGEMENT RULES.
