SUMMARIES OF AMENDMENTS AND COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTES

HOUSE BILLS

H 326. BUNCOMBE LOCAL SALES TAX FOR COMM. COLLEGES (NEW). Filed 3/10/11. House committee substitute deletes all provisions of the 1st edition and replaces with AN ACT TO ALLOW BUNCOMBE COUNTY TO RESTRICT USE OF THE ADDITIONAL ONE-QUARTER PERCENT SALES TAX TO COMMUNITY

COLLEGE CAPITAL OUTLAY PURPOSES, TO MAKE SUCH A RESTRICTION ON ANY SUCH TAX APPROVED BY THE VOTERS IN BUNCOMBE COUNTY IN 2011, TO PROVIDE FOR EXPIRATION OF THE TAX, AND TO REQUIRE A REVIEW AFTER TEN YEARS.

Allows the Buncombe County Commissioners to hold a referendum on placing restrictions on the use of the additional sales tax. Subject to a 2011 referendum approval by Buncombe County voters, provides that the 0.25% tax levied under GS 105-537 may only be used for community college capital outlay purposes and to retire indebtedness incurred by the county for such purposes, as detailed. Provides that the tax will expire 18 years after being levied. Requires a public hearing review of the tax during the tenth year of the levy.

SENATE BILLS

S 792. <u>ADJOURNMENT RESOLUTION</u>. Filed 9/12/11. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition.

Adds the following matters to the list of those eligible for consideration during the session reconvened on November 7, 2011: (1) appointment bills; (2) adoption of conference reports for bills in conference as of September 14, 2011; (3) local bills pending in the House Rules Committee on July 28, 2011; and (4) a bill to modify governance and management provisions for local management entities.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION TO PROVIDE THAT MARRIAGE BETWEEN ONE MAN AND ONE WOMAN IS THE ONLY DOMESTIC LEGAL UNION THAT SHALL BE VALID OR RECOGNIZED IN THIS STATE. Summarized in Daily Bulletin 9/12/11. Enacted September 14, 2011. Effective September 14, 2011.
