SUMMARIES OF AMENDMENTS AND COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTES

HOUSE BILLS

H 151. [ASK PARTY TO RELY ON NC COMPANIES AND WORKERS FOR DNC \(NEW\)](#). Filed 2/21/11. House committee substitute deletes all provisions of the 1st edition and replaces it with *A HOUSE RESOLUTION ASKING THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY TO RELY ON NORTH CAROLINA COMPANIES AND WORKERS FOR THE DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL CONVENTION IN 2012*.

States that the North Carolina House of Representatives urges the Democratic Party to rely on NC companies and workers for contracts leading up to and during the 2012 Democratic National Convention. Also urges the Democratic National Convention Committee to change its rules to respect NC's right-to-work laws and refrain from hiring workers and companies from outside of NC when qualified businesses and workers are available in the state. Includes whereas clauses.

Makes a change to a whereas clause to provide that the Democratic National Convention will (was, should) provide a considerable economic boost to Charlotte.
