H 39 (2017-2018) [AMEND APPOINTMENTS/UNC BD OF GOVERNORS](#). Filed Feb 2 2017, *AN ACT TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS ELECTED EACH REGULAR SESSION BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FROM SIXTEEN TO TWELVE AND TO MAKE CONFORMING CHANGES.*

AN ACT TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS ELECTED EACH REGULAR SESSION BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FROM SIXTEEN TO TWELVE AND TO MAKE CONFORMING CHANGES. Enacted March 3, 2017. Section 2 is effective July 1, 2017. Section 3 is effective July 1, 2019. The remainder is effective March 3, 2017.

H 254 (2017-2018) [SURPLUS COMPUTERS FOR LOW-INCOME STUDENTS](#). Filed Mar 6 2017, *AN ACT TO ALLOW THE STATE SURPLUS PROPERTY AGENCY TO DISTRIBUTE STATE SURPLUS COMPUTERS TO NONPROFIT ENTITIES THAT REFURBISH*

AND DONATE COMPUTERS FOR THE BENEFIT OF LOW-INCOME STUDENTS AND HOUSEHOLDS.

Under GS 143-64.03, the State Surplus Property Agency's duties include distributing surplus State-owned supplies, materials, and equipment to tax-supported or nonprofit tax-exempt organizations. Amends GS 143-64.02 to expand upon the definition of *nonprofit tax exempt organizations* to include nonprofits that refurbish computers for donation to low-income students or households.

Amends GS 143-548(d1), setting out the terms of appointments to the Vocational Rehabilitation Council, to add the representative of a parent training and information center to the specified Council members who may serve more than two consecutive full terms.

Amends GS 140-5.13(b), setting out the terms of appointments for the Board of Trustees of the North Carolina Museum of Art, providing that all appointments by the General Assembly are for terms of four years and that no person can be appointed to more than three consecutive terms (currently, all regular appointments by the General Assembly are for the then current legislative term, with no appointee serving more than two consecutive terms of two years).

H 259 (2017-2018) [GOT NATURAL MILK](#). Filed Mar 6 2017, *AN ACT ALLOWING THE DISPENSING OF RAW MILK AND RAW MILK PRODUCTS TO INDEPENDENT OR PARTIAL OWNERS OF LACTATING ANIMALS FOR PERSONAL USE OR CONSUMPTION.*

Amends GS 106-266.35, concerning the sale or dispensing of milk, to divide the existing provisions into subsections and to add new provisions establishing that nothing in the statute prohibits the dispensing of raw milk or raw milk products for personal use or consumption to, or the acquisition of raw milk or raw milk products for personal use or consumption by, an independent or partial owner of a cow, goat, or other lactating animal. Establishes that the labeling requirements for any raw milk or milk product dispensed as animal feed as specified in existing provisions does not apply to raw milk or raw milk products dispensed for personal use or consumption to the independent or partial owner of a cow, goat, or other lactating animal. Clarifies that the term *sale* or *sold* does not include the transfer or dispensing of raw milk products to, or the right to acquire raw milk or raw milk

products by, the independent or partial owner of a cow, goat, or other lactating animal. Makes conforming changes. Effective October 1, 2017.

Senate amendment #1 confirms Larry Hall as Secretary of the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs. Makes conforming changes to the long title and deletes the whereas clauses.

S 179 (2017-2018) [RECOGNIZE CHOWANOKE TRIBE](#). Filed Mar 6 2017, *AN ACT TO RESTORE OFFICIAL RECOGNITION TO THE CHOWANOKE NATION AS AN INDIAN TRIBE AND TO PROVIDE THEM WITH REPRESENTATION ON THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON INDIAN EDUCATION AND ON THE COMMISSION OF INDIAN AFFAIRS*.

Enacts new GS 71A-7.3 to restore official recognition to the Chowanoke Nation, giving them all their rights, privileges, and immunities as an American Indian Tribe with a recognized tribal governing body carrying out and exercising substantial governmental duties and powers similar to the State, and recognizing them as eligible for the special programs and services provided by the United States because of their status.

Amends GS 115C-210.1 by adding the Chowanoke Nation of Chowan, Gates, Hertford, and Perquimans counties to those tribes and organizations that are to be represented by the American Indian members on the State Advisory Council on Indian Education.

Amends GS 143B-407 by expanding the membership of the State Commission of Indian Affairs to include two members of the Chowanoke Nation.

S 182 (2017-2018) [PROHIBIT USE OF LIGHT BARS ON MOTOR VEHICLES](#). Filed Mar 6 2017, *AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF LIGHT BAR LIGHTING DEVICES ON A MOTOR VEHICLE WHILE THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS BEING DRIVEN ON THE HIGHWAYS OF THIS STATE*.

Amends GS 20-130 to, excluding electronically modulated headlamps on motorcycles and specified public safety vehicles, prohibit driving a vehicle on a highway of this state while using a light bar lighting device, defined as a bar-shaped lighting device made up of multiple lamps capable of projecting a beam of light at an intensity greater than that allowed under the statute.

Applies to offenses committed on or after October 1, 2017.

S 184 (2017-2018) **EVIDENCE PASSED VEHICLE IS A SCHOOL BUS**. Filed Mar 6 2017, *AN ACT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL METHODS FOR PROVING THAT A STOPPED VEHICLE PASSED BY ANOTHER MOTOR VEHICLE IS A "SCHOOL BUS" SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF G.S.20-217, TO REQUIRE LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS TO PROVIDE INSTRUCTION IN SCHOOL BUS SAFETY TO STUDENTS, AND TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION TO STUDY HOW THE SAFETY OF CHILDREN BOARDING AND EXITING SCHOOL BUSES MAY BE INCREASED.*

Section 1 amends GS 20-217(b). Deletes language making the statute applicable only when a school bus has a plainly visible sign saying "school bus" on the front and rear of the vehicle. Establishes that prima facie evidence that a vehicle is a school bus at the time of a violation of subsection (a) of the statute is (1) a certified copy of a record from the Division of Motor Vehicles showing that the vehicle was registered as a school bus, admissible as evidence without further authentication or (2) testimony from the school bus driver, a passenger on the school bus, or the law enforcement officer investigating the violation of subsection (a) of the statute. Clarifies that school buses include privately owned school buses transporting children (currently includes privately owned buses transporting children). Makes a technical change. Effective October 1, 2017, and applicable to offenses committed on or after that date.

Section 2 amends GS 115C-242. Directs local school administrative units to provide instruction in school bus safety to all elementary school students every school year, as developed by the State Board of Education, beginning with the 2017-18 school year.

Section 3 directs the Department of Public Instruction and the Department of Transportation to study procedures and equipment that may be used to increase school bus safety for children, including the feasibility and cost of equipping school buses with a device to provide a barrier between children and motor vehicles that may be approaching a bus. Directs the Department of Public Instruction to report its findings and recommendations to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee by January 15, 2018.

Except as otherwise indicated, the act is effective when it becomes law.

S 186 (2017-2018) **INCREASE SAMPSON COUNTY OCCUPANCY TAX**. Filed Mar 6 2017, *AN ACT TO INCREASE THE AUTHORIZATION FOR SAMPSON COUNTY TO LEVY AN OCCUPANCY TAX.*

Amends SL 2007-63, Section 1, to add a new subsection (a1) authorizing the Sampson County Board of Commissioners to levy an additional room occupancy tax of up to 3%. Provides that both the existing and additional tax must be levied, administered, collected, and repealed as provided in GS 153A-155 (Uniform provisions for room occupancy taxes). Prohibits Sampson County from levying this tax unless it also levies the tax previously authorized under SL 2007-63, Section 1(a), which levies a room occupancy tax of 3%. Makes a conforming change.

Filed Mar 6 2017, *AN ACT TO PROHIBIT DISTRIBUTION OF STATE AID TO MUNICIPALITIES FOR STREETS, KNOWN AS POWELL BILL FUNDS, IN ANY FISCAL YEAR THE MUNICIPALITY IS IN VIOLATION OF STATE LAW PROHIBITING SANCTUARY ORDINANCES, POLICIES, OR PROCEDURES.*

Amends GS 136-41.2, which details the eligibility parameters for municipalities to receive funds for public street maintenance and improvements appropriated under GS 136-41.1. Establishes that no municipality may receive funds under GS 136-41.1 in any fiscal year that the municipality is in violation of GS 160A-205.2, which prohibits the adoption of sanctuary ordinances, as determined by the Department of Transportation.

S 189 (2017-2018) [TOLLING OF MISD. STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS](#). Filed Mar 6 2017, *AN ACT TO AMEND THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS FOR MISDEMEANORS CHARGED THROUGH ANY CRIMINAL PROCESS AND TO PROVIDE FOR TOLLING OF THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS WHEN MISDEMEANORS ARE DISMISSED WITH LEAVE.*

Amends GS 15-1. Tolls the statute of limitations for crimes of deceit and malicious mischief, and the crime of petit larceny where the value of the property does not exceed \$5, and all misdemeanors except malicious misdemeanors, during the time a misdemeanor is dismissed with leave. Requires those same crimes to be charged (was, presented or found by the grand jury) within two years after the commission of the crime, and clarifies that the provision preserving the validity of a defective indictment preserves any criminal process.

Effective December 1, 2017, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.

S 190 (2017-2018) [THE HALEY HAYES NEWBORN SCREENING BILL](#). Filed Mar 6 2017, *AN ACT DIRECTING THE COMMISSION FOR PUBLIC HEALTH TO ADOPT RULES TO ADD A SCREENING TEST FOR POMPE DISEASE, MUCOPOLYSACCHARIDOSIS TYPE I (MPS I), AND X-LINKED ADRENOLEUKODYSTROPHY (X-ALD) TO THE NEWBORN SCREENING PROGRAM; INCREASING THE FEE FOR NEWBORN SCREENING TESTS; AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF PUBLIC HEALTH, TO PURCHASE NECESSARY EQUIPMENT AND UPGRADES AT THE STATE LABORATORY OF PUBLIC HEALTH FOR NEWBORN SCREENING AND ALL OTHER LABORATORY OPERATIONS.*

Contains whereas clauses.

Amends GS 130A-125 to raise the State Laboratory of Public Health test fee pursuant to this statute from \$44 to \$55. Directs the Commission for Public Health to amend the rules to implement the Newborn Screening Program to add to the newborn screening panel a screening test for Pompe disease, Mucopolysaccharidosis Type I, and X-Linked Adrenoleukodystrophy.

Appropriates \$2.7 million for 2017-18 from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health for the purchase of laboratory instrumentation and upgrades to the existing North Carolina State Laboratory of Public Health Laboratory Information System.

Effective July 1, 2017, and applies to laboratory tests conducted on and after July 1, 2017.

Filed Mar 6 2017, *AN ACT REQUIRING MUNICIPALITIES IN STANLY COUNTY TO OBTAIN THE CONSENT OF THE STANLY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS PRIOR TO ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT OR MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH A COUNTY, MUNICIPALITY, SPECIAL DISTRICT, OR OTHER UNIT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT THAT IS LOCATED WHOLLY OR PRIMARILY OUTSIDE STANLY COUNTY.*

Requires municipalities in Stanly County to obtain approval of the county commissioners prior to entering into, renewing, or amending a contract or memorandum of understanding with a unit of local government located wholly or primarily outside Stanly County.

Effective when the act becomes law, and applies to contracts or memorandums of understanding executed, or amended or renewed, on or after that date.
