H 797 (2021) [EXTEND FARMERS/FISHERMEN TAX FILING DEADLINE. \(NEW\)](#) Filed May 3 2021, *AN ACT TO EXTEND THE MARCH 1 TAX FILING DEADLINE FOR FARMERS AND FISHERMEN IN ORDER TO ALLOW THEM TO QUALIFY FOR THE EXCEPTION THAT PERMITS THEM TO AVOID MAKING ESTIMATED TAX PAYMENTS THROUGHOUT THE TAXABLE YEAR WITHOUT THE IMPOSITION OF INTEREST.*

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE MARCH 1 TAX FILING DEADLINE FOR FARMERS AND FISHERMEN IN ORDER TO ALLOW THEM TO QUALIFY FOR THE EXCEPTION THAT PERMITS THEM TO AVOID MAKING ESTIMATED TAX PAYMENTS THROUGHOUT THE TAXABLE YEAR WITHOUT THE IMPOSITION OF INTEREST.
